Front Entry: New Intercom System

Is up and running - give yourself extra time when coming to the school

For the safety and security of our students and staff, the front door will be locked from 9:25 am (10:25 Mon) until approximately 3:00 pm. During the day you will need to ring the doorbell (RED lit button) located to the left of the door on the wall. This will activate a bell and video/photo recording in the office. If you are unknown to the person answering the bell, you will be required to state your name and purpose of visit and show photo ID.

Please be patient if we are away from our desks; the bell is loud enough we can hear from the copy room, health room, etc. and we will be with you as soon as possible.

Warm weather reminders

As we see warmer weather (YAY!) please remember to follow the warm weather **district dress code**.

- ✓ Skirts and shorts must not be any higher than the middle of the thigh
- ✓ Shirts: No low cut, tube, one-shoulder, halter, spaghetti strap, see-through or bareback (general guideline for straps – two finger width)
- ✓ No flip-flops: sandals providing adequate support may be worn (general guideline –have a back strap)

Sunscreen Update:

As the weather improves, we are happy to share that Washington recently passed a law that allows students to bring sunscreen to school and to self-apply it. We welcome you to take advantage of this opportunity to better protect your child's health. Please see the important directions below before sending sunscreen with your child.

Students will apply the sunscreen to themselves. Staff will not be able to help.

1. Write your student's **name** on the sunscreen container with a permanent marker.
2. Send ONLY **rub-on sunscreen** to school.
 - a. Many students do not have the coordination to effectively apply spray sunscreens only on themselves.
 - b. Spray sunscreens in the crowded school settings are a recipe for getting sunscreen in the eyes, mouths and noses of other students.
 - c. Spray sunscreens are particularly risky for our students with asthma and other respiratory conditions.
